

Sunday Obligation Reinstated:

- ✝ The obligation to attend Sunday Mass in the Diocese of Saginaw has been reinstated as of October 1, 2020. All people who are sick in any way or have concerns about underlying health issues and maybe vulnerable to the disease are encouraged to remain home. A well-informed conscience does not bind a person to the obligation to attend Mass in these circumstances, and therefore a reason to miss Mass would not be a sin.
- ✝ You **do not** need to make a reservation.
- ✝ Please maintain the social distancing and sit six feet apart except for couples and families who live in the same household. On the top back of the pews you will find blue tape to mark where to sit.
- ✝ You must wear your mask or face covering during the entire celebration of the Mass.
- ✝ There is a locked box at the entrance of the church to drop your contribution in before or after Mass.
- ✝ Bulletins will not be printed. You can read the bulletin on the parish website and app.
- ✝ Distribution of Communion will be after the Mass. You are to receive Communion in the hand, no gloves are allowed. Fr. Theo will remove his vestment and put on a mask. The ushers will release a pew at a time, please follow the directions from the usher. As you come forward to receive Communion follow the blue crosses on the floor to keep the six feet social distancing. When you are next in line to receive Communion remove your mask or face covering, step forward to receive Communion in your hand, step aside and place the Eucharist in your mouth to consume, place your mask/face covering back over your face and then proceed out the door to the parking lot.
